Action Required by April 10: Student & Family Data Form

Every Rollins student is required to review their contact information data and make any updates by Monday, April 10, 2020. Here's how to access the Student and Family Data Form (it's really easy!)

Log into your Foxlink account and click on the "Student Registration" tab, where you'll find the Student and Family Data Form.

Yes! You need to log in to verify the Student and Family Data Form. Even if you think your information is correct, you still need to log in and verify (or update) your personal information and any parent or family contact information. Every Rollins student is REQUIRED to review, confirm, and make appropriate adjustments to their existing data in order to complete the form.
