The Audubon Park Ball Fields are a series of formal and informal baseball and softball fields in between Brookshire West Elementary School and a shopping plaza on Corrine Drive. The parks's central location provides convenient pedestrian and bicycle access to residents of Audubon Park that live South of Corrine.

The park consists of three fenced and gated ball fields of various little league size, a few open practice fields and two basketball courts. Covered bleachers, a pavilion and numerous large oaks provide some shade for park users. There is a fenced community garden on the East edge of the park, along Winter Park Road that grows vegetables and ornamental flowers.

Park improvements were funded in 2001 by Orange County's "Field of Dreams" Grant Program. The ball fields appear to be in good condition and appear to be used frequently. The fields behind them are used by neighborhood residents as open space for pick up sports games or dog runs.
