- Early Decision is a binding program. Two rounds of Early Decision are offered. Accepted students are expected to withdraw applications from other colleges. Early Decision Round I application deadline is November 15; notification date is December 15. Early Decision Round II application deadline is January 15; notification date is February 1.
- Regular Decision application deadline is February 15; notification date is April 1.
- Priority Scholarship deadline is January 5.

- The 3/2 Accelerated Management Program (AMP) is available to first-year applicants only and results in the Bachelor of Arts (BA) from Rollins and the Master of Business Administration (MBA) from Rollins' Roy E. Crummer Graduate School of Business. Admission is highly selective; admitted candidates are expected to maintain a 3.2 or higher grade point average and score at least 600 on the Graduate Management Aptitude Test (GMAT) in order to matriculate in the Crummer School.

The Test Score Waived Option is NOT appropriate for applicants wishing to be considered for academic scholarships. However, TSWO applicants are still eligible for need-based financial aid.

Candidates selecting TSWO must submit 2 supplemental items:

1. A **representation** of your strengths, talents, and interests.
Your representation should help us better understand who you are and your potential to contribute to the Rollins community. The method of presentation is only limited by your imagination and creativity. Consider the following when preparing your representation:
 - It is very important that your representation is prepared specifically for Rollins and is not something you used for another purpose.
 - If you are sending a video or audio clip, limit your piece to 5 minutes or less.
 - Representations will not be returned.
2. A **teacher recommendation** from one of your core academic courses during the junior or senior year.
