The more you participate the more points you receive. Points will go toward activity eligibility. Only students who have a certain amount of points will be eligible to participate in future UB trips. Students receive point updates at the beginning of each week.

Guess what? Students are now eligible to receive \$20 stipends. You heard me right, \$20. Students who complete their weekly check-ins with Ms. Kim and Ms. J in addition to attending the Saturday Session will receive \$20 stipends. If the student only attends Saturday Session they will only receive the standard \$10 stipend for participating.
