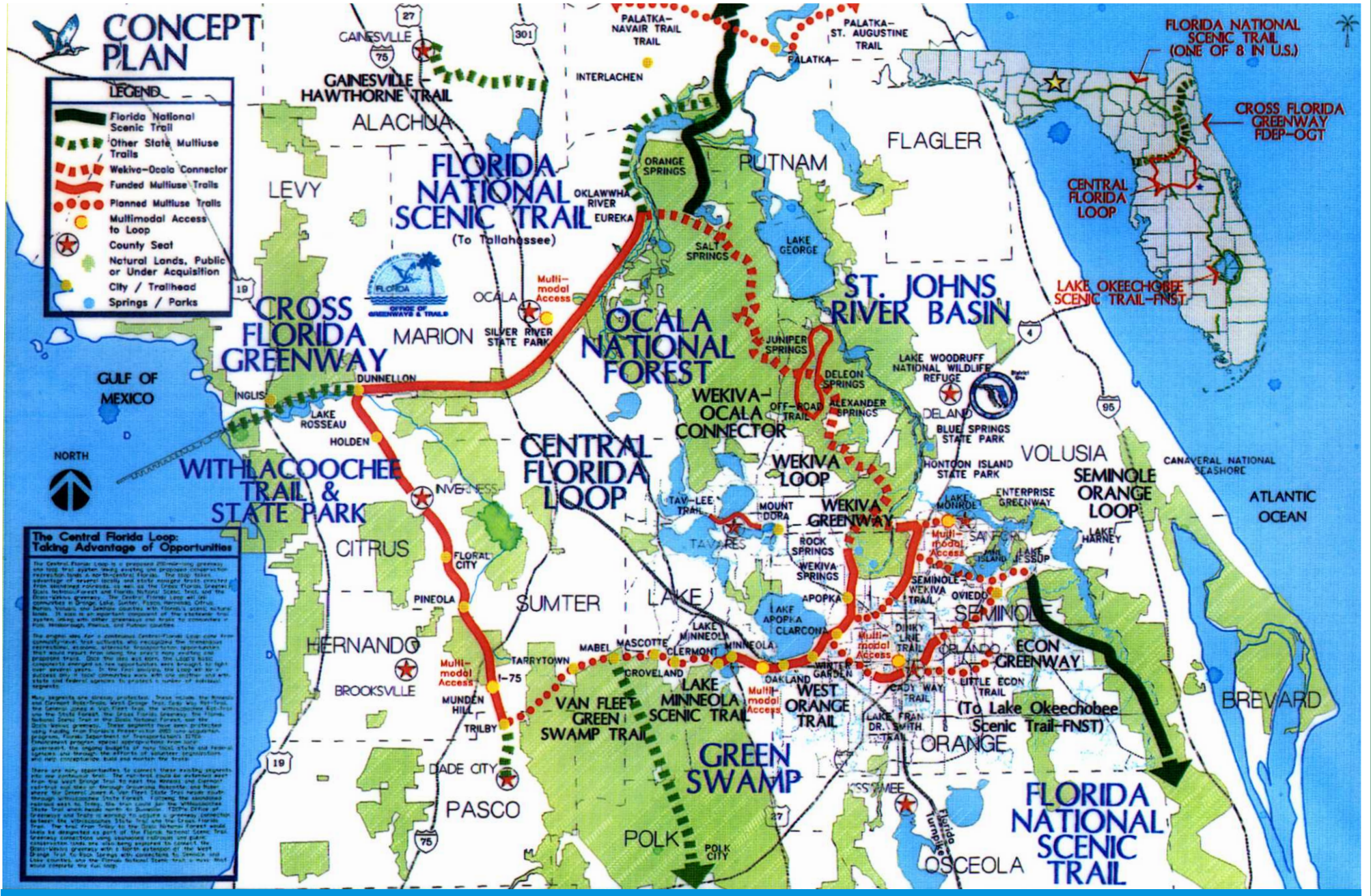

**The Central Florida Loop: Taking Advantage of Opportunities**

The Central Florida Loop is a proposed planning process that will identify and evaluate existing and proposed transportation infrastructure in north-central Florida. The loop takes advantage of several locally and state managed lands created from abandoned roadbeds, such as the Green Swamp, Lake Toxapane, and the Florida National Scenic Trail, and the Florida National Scenic Trail. The loop also connects to other trails, such as the Cross Florida Greenway, the Wekiva-Ocala Connector, and the Van Fleet Green Trail. It is an important component of the statewide trail system, along with other proposed and existing trails, such as the Palatka-Navair Trail, the Palatka-St. Augustine Trail, and the Van Fleet Green Trail.
