 - *Chapter was charged with a violation of the code 3-5 cases (- 5 points)*
 - *Chapter was found responsible to Community Standards Responsibility (-15points)*

This portion of the CCR will be reviewed with the following criteria:

- *House Manager/Wellness Series Coordinator Candidate Selection:*
 - *Chapter provided at least 3 qualified candidates for 2020-2021 House Manager Selection (6 points)*
- *Occupancy*
 - *Chapter was at 100% Occupancy for SP 19/FL 19 (5 points)*
 - *Chapter was at 90% average occupancy for SP 19/FL 19 (0 points)*
 - *Chapter was below a 90% average occupancy for SP 19/FL 19 (- 5 points)*
- *Conduct within RO*
 - *Chapter was found responsible for 0-2 incidents (0 points)*
 - *Chapter was found responsible for 3-4 incidents (- 5 points)*
 - *Chapter was found responsible for 4 incidents (-10 points)*

Total Possible Points: 11 points

Section 6: Wellness Series Programming

- An evaluation of the organization's completion of the Wellness Series based on:
 - Completing all required programs as determined by the start of the wellness series
 - Completing the post survey

This portion of the CCR will be reviewed with the following criteria:

- *Program Completion*
 - *Completed all WS programs: 10 points*
 - *Did not complete all WS Programs: - 10 points*
- *Post Wellness Series Survey Completion*
 - *Above 75% completed: 10 points*
 - *75% completed: 5 points*
 - *Less than 75% completed: - 10 points*
- *Wellness Series Coordinator Candidate Selection:*
 - *Chapter provided at least 3 qualified candidates for 2020-2021 House Manager Selection (6 points)*

Total Possible Points: 26 points
