# **FALL 2016 TOPICS COURSES**

Topical course descriptions provided below are not available in the College Catalogue.

ANT 305P Topic: Medical Anthropology. Medical anthropology is the study of health and illness and its connection to cultural, political, social, economic, and historical phenomena. As a diverse area of study, medical anthropology blends cultural, biological and applied perspectives in considering questions related to human health. Students will use a cross-cultural perspective to consider how health and illness are differentially experienced across the globe and examine how social factors influence disease distributions and determinants. Students will also learn about diverse types of healing systems, treatment modalities, and culturally specific syndromes that contribute to

a deeper and broader understanding of how health is conceived, experienced and managed.

**ENV 305U** *Topic: Florida Field Ecology*. An in-depth exploration of Florida habitats and ecological field methods. From mangrove swamps on the southern coasts to the temperate forests of the panhandle, Florida encompasses far more diversity across its landscape than most people realize. We explore the habitats of Florida both in the classroom and on field trips during occasional extended class periods. Students learn essential field methods for ecosystem monitoring and restoration, as well

as techniques for identification of important native species. Class discussions explore human impacts on Florida habitats and strategies for responsible management.

PHY 210A Topic: Acoustics. A study of acoustical phenomenon beginning with basic oscillations and waves and how all of these disciplines can be combined. Possible topics to include: structural acoustics and vibrations, digital signal processing, underwater and atmospheric acoustics, sound propagation in different media, musical acoustics, psychological and physiological acoustics and computational acoustics techniques.
